Annual Wellness Exams (AWE)

What are they?

During your pets AWE, the Veterinarian will complete a full physical exam (nose-to-tail), which includes, but is not limited to the eyes, ears, mouth, heart and lungs. Once completed, they will discuss their findings with you and build any necessary treatment plans. At the end of the appointment, the Veterinarian will administer any vaccinations that are due, and prepare any parasite prevention discussed during your appointment.

Why is it Important?

It's important to bring your pet in on an annual basis, as it allows for us to keep track of their overall well-being, gives us the opportunity to catch arising health issues, and provides us with ample time for early intervention.

Please Note

If your pet requires diagnostic testing and/or extensive treatment, you will be referred out to another clinic or emergency centre.
